He also is an expert in interventional cardiology procedures like Balloon valvuloplasty, Pacemaker implantation, PDA occlusion using duct occluder.

His name was inscribed in the Limca book of records for performing the first pacemaker implantation surgery in a dog in India.

He strongly believes in teamwork, continuous learning, and contributing to a collaborative, multi-specialty veterinary ecosystem.

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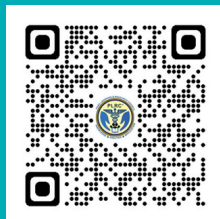
